Instead, **Year 2 only** will celebrate **Children in Need Day** on **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> November**. The Student Council members have spoken to their classes for fundraising ideas. Many children asked for the mini fete to celebrate the day again as they really enjoyed it the last time we were able to do it.

Throughout the day, classes will visit the 'Mini fete' in the Sports Hall where there will be lots of activities on offer.
