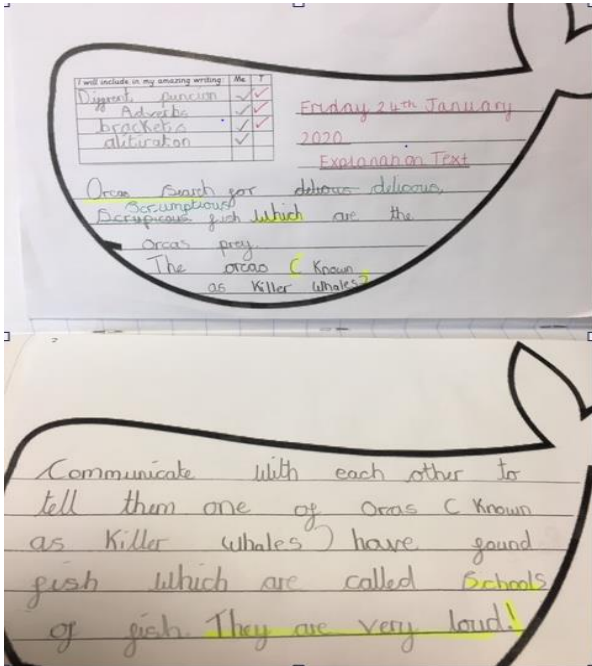


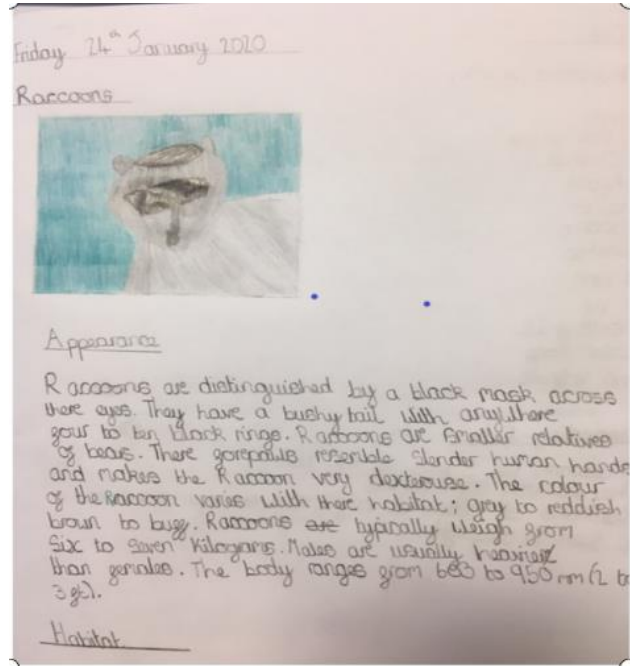
Principal's Message

Children in Y4 loved using the Virtual Reality Goggles this week. Camron and Paige from class 14 told me: "We got to see what the rainforest looks like. One bit had a gorilla really close by, and some people screamed! It was hard to find the snake because it was camouflaged in the leaves on the forest floor. We could experience what the rainforest is like without travelling all the way to the Amazon in South America."

The reading characters are used daily to help children focus on a particular skill. Suzanne from class 17 told me: "If it's the Inferring IbeX, then we have to infer. We work in three stages. If it's Read Aloud Raccoon, then this helps you read with expression, using punctuation and voices for personalities".

Well done to those of you who have already read 4 times and got stamps in your reading diaries – I am really impressed with Curtis in class 13, who already has 3 stamps – great work!
