

## Activities within the local area during Summer Holiday period 2020

- Sports Hall phased re-opening during Summer holidays
- Aspley Library - Running online sessions (tots time, story time, crafts, reading groups) summer reading challenge.
- Stonebridge City Farm is open for families to see the animals - at present no petting or feeding. The playground is also open. This may change as they are reviewing the situation on a week by week basis.
- Greens Windmill is closed at present.
- Nature reserves and local parks throughout Nottingham are open with social distancing measures in place but no events or activities planned. The Nottingham Wildlife Trust has a web page listing lots of local parks such as 'Little Holly Corner' which may give families somewhere different to visit, to maybe have picnics or ride bikes etc.
- All Nottingham libraries are open but reduced hours (these may vary between libraries) no planned activities though.
- Melbourne Park planning free football sessions- awaiting confirmation but should be Free sessions every Tuesday for 6-10 year olds running from 5pm-6pm. Education FC Facebook for further details.
