

Key stage 1 and Key stage 2 children

It has been lovely to welcome all of the children back to school. We would like to thank you for your support with the staggered start, and different entry points. We know it was too crowded, however, and confusing for some families, while being frustrating for others.

We always aim to do our very best for all of our pupils and parents, and as a result we will make the following changes for drop off and pick-up at school.

We will allow parents on site so there is more space for distancing.

For Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 children (classes 4-21):

Drop off arrangements

- We will open the gates of Minver Crescent and Hilcot Drive for you to come onto the school playground with your child.
- When you enter the site you must observe social distancing and stand on a spot on the playground where your child's classroom door is visible.
- **We ask that only one adult attends the site per family. The classroom doors for these year groups will open at 8.40am and will remain open until 9am.**
- You will be able to kiss, cuddle and wave bye to your child from your spot as you watch them go into the classroom door. Your child can arrive anytime between 8.40am and 9am.

Collection arrangements

- To collect your child from school we ask that you arrive between 3pm and 3.15pm and stand on a spot where the classroom door is visible (on Fridays, 12-12:15pm)
- All staff will open the door at 3pm (or at 12pm on Friday) and will send your child to you whilst you wait on the spot.
- As soon as you have picked up your child you must leave the school site immediately.
- We ask that you do not go near classroom doors to speak to staff
- Members of SLT will be positioned on the external gates and will pass on any messages for you

We hope that this will feel safer for all of us.
